Greetings in the name of Jesus Christ and Happy New Year in the Year of our Lord 2025!





## **News From the Service Ministry**

#### Looking Back on 2024, and Forward to 2025

The Service Ministry is grateful for the dedication and generosity of the good people of St. Timothy's. In 2024 you supported four food drives, donated used musical instruments for middle and high school students, fed warm meals to the unhoused, donated new backpacks to school children and responded with abundant generosity to the Gift Cards for Kids program this Christmas time. Truly, St. Tim's is the heart of our community. We thank you profusely for your tremendous support!

With the money allocated to the Service Ministry from the General Fund we purchased coats for the Hunter Mill Winter Coat Closet, purchased nearly 1,000 diapers for LINK, donated \$250 to the Boys Home of Virginia and \$1,500 to the Episcopal Church of the Transfiguration (ECT) in Bat Cave, NC. ECT is one of the churches in the Diocese of Western North Carolina that was badly affected by Tropical Storm Helene in late September. Their building still stands but the area surrounding it, including roads into the area were devastated. They do not know when they will be able to worship together in their own building. We are inspired by the resilience of their Rector, Fr. John Roberts, and the parishioners, who are rallying together to worship and to help each other. While our offering is small compared to the need, we know that it is deeply appreciated, and we are all hopeful that we may be able to assist in other ways.
